

REGULATIONS OF THE FIRST INTERNATIONAL EDITION OF THE FIFTH NATIONAL ACTION "BREAK FOR READING - BEATING THE RECORD IN READING ON BREAK"

I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The organizer of the action is the Pedagogical Library of the Provincial Methodical Center in Gorzów Wielkopolski.
2. The action is addressed to students, teachers, the local school and non-school community.
3. All types of educational institutions may participate in the action (e.g. primary schools, secondary schools, educational centers and others):
 - institutions located in Poland and partner institutions cooperating with them located outside Polish borders;
 - Polish-language schools around the world (e.g. Polish schools at diplomatic, consular and military representations of the Republic of Poland).
4. The action is carried out as part of the International Month of School Libraries and "The Whole Poland Reads to Children" social campaign.
5. Honorary patronage over the action was taken by: Marshal of the Lubuskie Voivodeship - Elżbieta Anna Polak, Education Superintendent of Lubuskie - Ewa Rawa, Education Development Center, Center for the Development of Polish Education Abroad.
6. The rules of the campaign will be available on the website www.womgorz.edu.pl the BREAK FOR READING tab.

7. The action is organized on one day chosen by the institution between October 1-31 2020 on all inter-lesson breaks.

II. OBJECTIVES

1. Promotion of reading among school-age children
2. Integration of the local environment and strengthening cooperation between Polish and foreign schools.
3. Draw students' attention to reading as an attractive way of spending free time at school.
4. Encourage students to reach for a book in every situation and in every place.
5. Beating last year's record, which was 158 809 people reading on break from 991 branches in Poland and 14 abroad.

III. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

1. Participation in the action is open, voluntary and free.
2. The action is not a competition, no prizes are planned.
3. The condition of participation in the action is the correct completion of the registration form available on the organizer's website.
4. Applications for the action are accepted until the end of September 2020.
5. The notified institution organizes a reading campaign on one day of its choice (October 1-31 2020) on or within the school on all breaks.
6. The school community (students, teachers, administration and other invited persons) reads

books (everyone reads its own book) in a place / places of their choice (there is no obligation to collect all participants in one place). School groups staying at that time outside of the institution, e.g. on school trips, can also take part in breaking the record.

7. For the youngest students (unable to read) we suggest creating Reading Zones where books will be read aloud by their colleagues, teachers or invited guests.

8. The notified institution may break the school record in rreading on break together with the partner institution located outside of Poland.

9. The participants document the conduct of the action in any manner of their choice (e.g. photos, video, etc.).

10. After the action, the notified institution is required to put description and photos from the campaign on its own website and / or social media.

11. Photos placed on social media are marked with hashtag # Breakforreading2020.

12. The institutions participating in the action shall complete a report prepared by the organizer, posted on the Pedagogical Library website (DEADLINE IS November 8, 2020)

13. The report form will be active from October 2, 2020.

14. The form should include:

- the details of the notified institution,
- the details of the partner institution (if it participated),
- the description of the course of action,
- the number of people reading on break,

- the exact link to the account of the course of the campaign is posted on the school / institution website or Facebook social profile (text, photos / videos).

15. By completing the form, you accept these terms and conditions and agree to the free publication of the information contained in the report by the organizer.

16. The organizer, after collecting all the reports, sums up the whole action. The results will be published on the Pedagogical Library website and the Library profile on Facebook, December 9, 2020.

IV. FINAL PROVISIONS

1. The organizer reserves the right to change the regulations, the changes come into force on the day of the publication on www.womgorz.edu.pl.

2. The institutions participating in the action will complete the report form and will be able to download a diploma (for Both an institution and a coordinator) confirming participation in the action. The documents will be available on the organizer's website.

3. Issues not regulated in the regulations are resolved individually by the organizer.
